Notification of Application: Carbon Dioxide Appraisal and Storage Licence

The Oil and Gas Authority ('**OGA**') has received an application for a Carbon Dioxide Appraisal and Storage Licence pursuant to Chapter 3 of the Energy Act 2008 (the '**Act**'), in respect of the following area (the '**Area**'):

A polygon, the boundary of which is defined by parallels of Latitude and Meridians joining the following points, as defined on European Datum First Adjustment 1950:

53° 41′ 00″N, 3° 37′ 00″W 53° 41′ 00″N, 3° 07′ 00″W 53° 35′ 00″N, 3° 07′ 00″W 53° 35′ 00″N, 3° 21′ 00″W 53° 33′ 00″N, 3° 21′ 00″W 53° 33′ 00″N, 3° 23′ 00″W 53° 28′ 00″N, 3° 23′ 00″W 53° 28′ 00″N, 3° 37′ 00″W 53° 41′ 00″N, 3° 37′ 00″W

Any persons wishing to make an application for a Carbon Dioxide Appraisal and Storage Licence in respect of all or part of the Area must notify the OGA at **Offshore.Exploration@ogauthority.co.uk** of their intention to do so within **14 calendar days** from the date of this Notice (by **5 p.m. BST on Monday 6**th **July 2020**) (the '**Deadline**'). Such persons will then be required to submit their completed application within a further 21 calendar days (by 5 p.m. BST on Monday 27th July 2020). If you have not given notice to the OGA on or before the Deadline, you will <u>not</u> subsequently be able to submit an application for the Area unless informed otherwise.

Please be aware that (among other necessary consents and approvals) a Crown Estate Lease is required in order to carry out carbon dioxide storage activities in accordance with the Act.
